

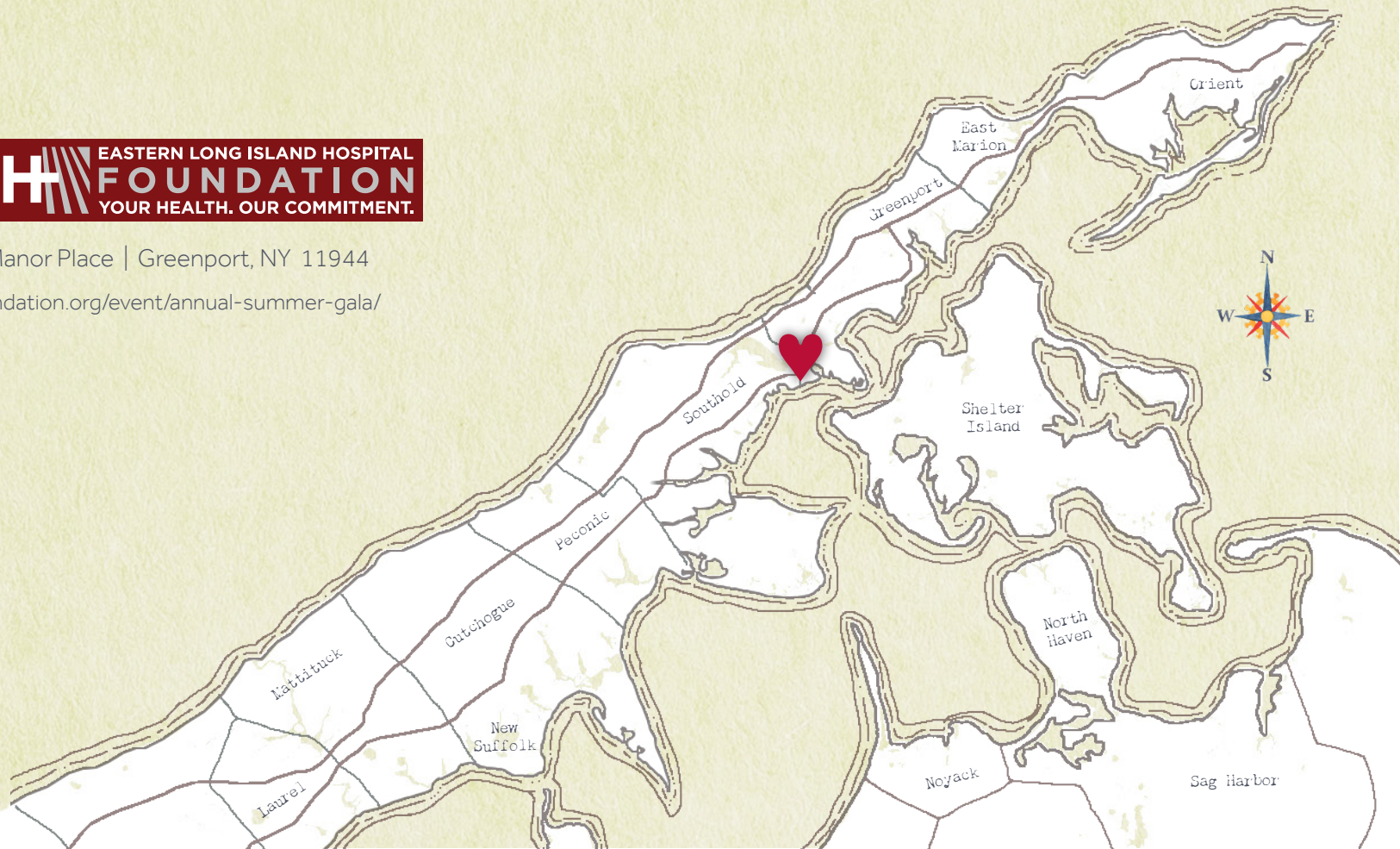

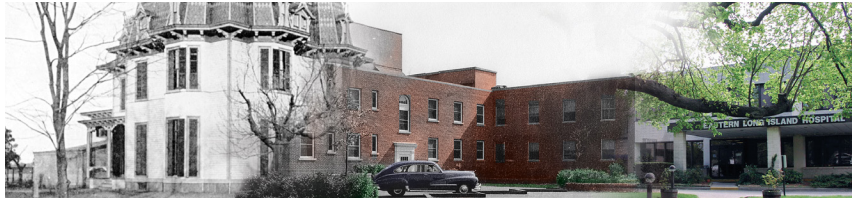

Our Story

Stony Brook Eastern Long Island Hospital (SBELIH), originally Eastern Long Island Hospital (ELIH), recently celebrated 120 years of continuous service to the residents of the North Fork and Shelter Island. Founded in 1905 as Suffolk County's first voluntary hospital, its beginnings trace back to a Victorian mansion donated by the Wood Sisters. Through the efforts of the Eastern Long Island Hospital Association and the Ladies' Auxiliary, the mansion was transformed into a facility for patient care, equipped with a steam heating system and x-ray machine by 1916.

Over the decades, the hospital expanded in both size and scope. The 1920s through the 1980s brought vital upgrades including a children's ward, delivery room, ICU-CCU, mental health services, and an alcohol rehab center. In the 2000s, a period of major growth began with the opening of the Gladys Brooks Ambulatory Surgery Pavilion (2001), a new Emergency Department (2004), and the founding of the Eastern Long Island Hospital Foundation (2006), which strengthened philanthropic support. A state-of-the-art Diagnostic Imaging Center followed in 2008.

Joining the Stony Brook Medicine system in 2019 marked a new era. In the years that followed, SBELIH invested in upgraded diagnostic and patient care technologies and expanded Quannacut Outpatient services. Notable projects included the Narcan Rescue Station program, the Food as Medicine initiative with C.A.S.T., and the opening of new Recovery Homes. In 2024, the Harold Family Clinical Laboratory was dedicated, bringing enhanced lab capabilities to the East End.

Looking ahead, SBELIH is working toward Primary Stroke Center designation in 2025. The ELIH Foundation and ELIH Auxiliary continue to play key roles in supporting these efforts. From its humble roots to its current role as a clinical campus of Stony Brook Medicine, SBELIH remains a cornerstone of care for our community.
